Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed. Vote either "Yes" or "No", or "For" or "Against", on any issue.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that question will not be counted.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

**5 Proposed Bond Issue
Lancaster City School District**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall bonds be issued by Lancaster City School District for the purpose of **constructing school facilities and renovating existing facilities under a program of the Ohio Facilities Construction Commission and locally funded initiatives; furnishing and equipping the same; improving the sites thereof; and acquiring land and interest in land** in the principal amount of \$66,125,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of thirty-seven (37) years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue three and seven-tenths (3.7) mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to thirty-seven cents (\$0.37) for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?
