Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.

- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that question will not be counted.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

**1 Proposed Tax Levy
(Renewal)
Clearcreek Township**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Clearcreek Township, for the purpose of general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in the unincorporated territory of the township at a rate not exceeding one half (0.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.
