Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed. Vote either "Yes" or "No", or "For" or "Against", on any issue.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that question will not be counted.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

6 Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Walnut Township Local School District

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Walnut Township Local School District for the purpose of **providing for the emergency requirements of the school district** in the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average six and three-tenths (6.3) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to sixty-three cents (\$0.63) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years, commencing in 2020, first due in calendar year 2021.

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) Village of Buckeye Lake

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the Village of Buckeye Lake for the purpose of police protection and services at a rate not exceeding five (5) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to fifty cents (\$0.50) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Village of Buckeye Lake

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of the Village of Buckeye Lake for the purpose of current expenses at a rate not exceeding one (1) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to ten cents (\$0.10) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for five (5) years, commencing in 2019, first due in calendar year 2020.
