Instructions to Voter

- **To vote:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of your choice.
- Note the permitted number of choices directly below the title of each candidate office. Do not mark the ballot for more choices than allowed.
- If you mark the ballot for more choices than permitted, that contest or question will not be counted.
- **To vote for a write-in candidate:** completely darken the oval (●) to the left of the blank line and write in the candidate's name. Only votes cast for candidates who filed as write-in candidates can be counted.
- Do not write-in a candidate's name if that person's name is already printed on the ballot for that same contest.
- **If you make a mistake or want to change your vote:** return your ballot to an election official and get a new ballot. You may ask for a new ballot up to two times.

**2 Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Fairfield County, Ohio for the purpose of **general construction, reconstruction, and repair of County, Township and certain Municipal bridges, replacement or extension of County and Township road culverts and general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of County roads** at a rate not exceeding five-tenths (0.5) mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a continuing period, commencing in 2014, first due in calendar year 2015.

**3 Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Fairfield County for the purpose of **supporting services for older adult residents (aged 60 and older) provided by or through meals on wheels, including but not limited to: home delivered meals, congregate site meals and activities, nutrition education, nutrition counseling, caregiver relief and support services, minor home repair and chores assistance, transportation and other aging services** at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to five cents (\$0.05) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a period of five (5) years commencing in 2014, first due in calendar year 2015.

## 25 Proposed Replacement of Income Tax

Berne Union Local School District  
Fairfield and Hocking Counties, Ohio

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall the existing tax of one percent (1%) on the school district income of individuals and estates imposed by the Berne Union Local School District be replaced by a tax of two percent (2%) on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district for ten (10) years, beginning January 1, 2014, for the purpose of paying current operating expenses of the School District? If the new tax is not approved, the existing tax will remain in effect under its original authority, for the remainder of its previously approved term.
